

He also works as a research associate at the UC Davis Medical Center Emergency Department and participates as a student advisor on the Chancellor’s Undergraduate Advisory Board. Grant, who has made the Dean’s List every quarter at UC Davis and has been the recipient of the Regents Scholar and Provost Award, is expected to graduate in June 2018.
